Facebook does not have a "black list" function, the relationship can only be deleted from the friends list.

People sometimes might be impulsive, maybe there was a period of time we were not like someone, and deleted him from our friends list on Facebook.

Do not rule out this possibility: After some time, we do not hate him, and would like to continue communicating with him on Facebook. But we have deleted him from our friends list, we can only re-add him back to our friends list, so he will receive your friend request again, he will know you ever deleted him, this might bring a bad feeling to him. So if Facebook has a blacklist function, so that when the person is dragged in the blacklist, friends and relations will not be deleted directly, but we will not see any information of him anymore (just like deleting him on Facebook). However, if we want to re-focus him, then drag him out from the blacklist, it will not re-send a friend request. Just in case.

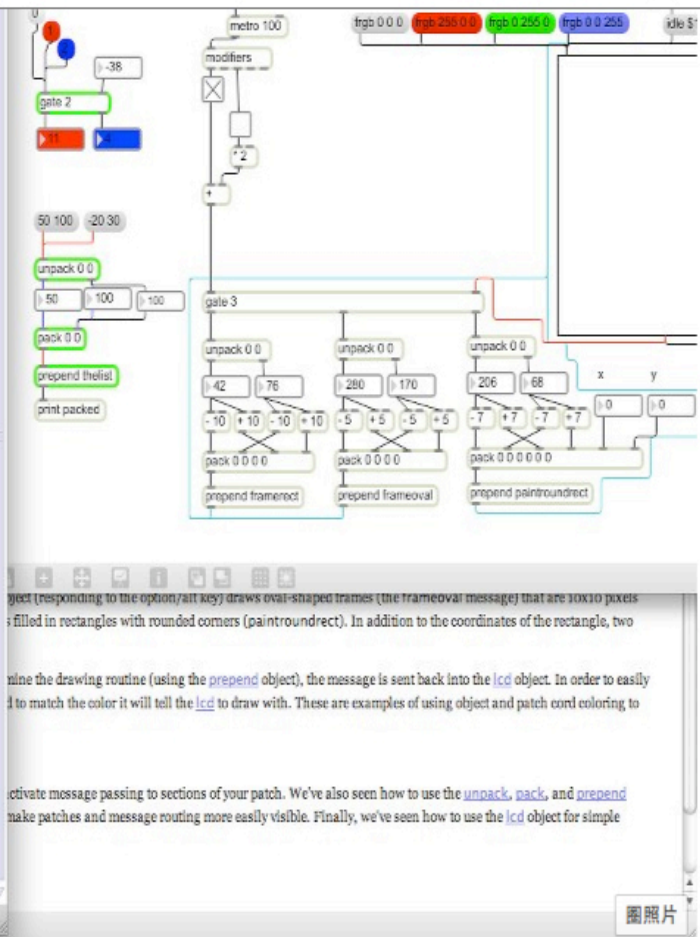
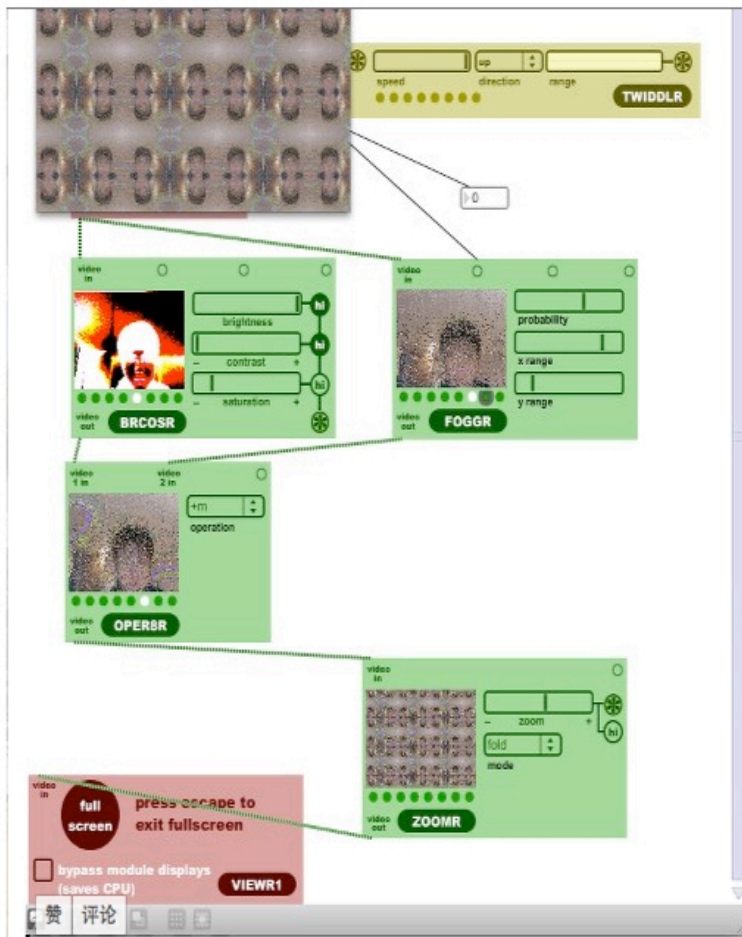


# Photo Transferring

The photos in one album can not be directly transferred to another album. If people want to transfer some photos to another album, they have to delete the photos and reupload them.

Sometimes people might need this function to transfer photos directly rather than delete them and re-upload to another album.
